(Be prepared for an overnight hike as well as living in camp.)

Required

- ___ BSA belt
- ___ Watch with alarm clock
- ___ Shoes, suitable for hiking
- ___ Change of shoes, as desired
- ___ Raincoat, poncho, or rain suit
- ___ Light sweater or jacket
- ___ Underclothing (5 sets, minimum)
- ___ Activity socks (as needed)
- ___ Handkerchiefs (as needed)
- ___ Pajamas / sweat suit
- ___ Towels (2)
- ___ Washcloths (2)
- ___ Toothbrush and paste
- ___ Hand soap, shampoo, deodorant
- ___ Lightweight personal tent for week
- ___ Required / prescribed medication
- ___ Sunscreen/ chap stick
- ___ Insect repellent (non aerosol only)
- ___ Backpack (with frame to hike in gear)
- ___ Plate, bowl, and cup
- ___ Knife, fork, and spoon
- ___ Canteen/ water bottle
- ___ Tent with Ground cloth (water proof)
- ___ Sleeping bag
- ___ Sleeping pad
- ___ Flashlight / extra batteries
- ___ Personal sewing kit
- ___ Personal first aid kit
- ___ Pen, pencil, paper
- ___ Scout pocketknife & totin' chip
(no fixed blades)
- ___ Boy Scout Handbook
- ___ Personal Health and Medical form
- ___ 100 feet of 3/8 in. rope
- ___ Bag for dirty clothes

Do Not Bring:

- Extra food**
- Electronic Toys / equipment**
- Butane lighters**
- Fireworks**
- Cell Phones**

*NYLT Hat, Neckerchief, Slide, and 2 Activity Shirts will be issued after arrival

Cell phones will not be permitted. Cameras, GPS and other applications should be brought as standalone equipment. If cell phones are found, they will be confiscated and returned at end of course.

Note:

- All Participants will be in full BSA uniform before moving to the campsites. Before coming, make sure that all badges and insignia are properly placed on uniform.
- A pack must be used for getting gear from the jumping off place to the campsite.
 - (Do not bring suitcases, footlockers, trunks, or wagons to the course.)
- Normal prescribed patrol equipment will be issued at camp - excluding a tent.
